One of the most popular parks in the region, Doran Regional Park has more than 120 campsites and a large, sandy beach ideal for hiking, fishing, birding, beachcombing, wading, and water sports. It also has a small boat craft launch, including an accessible kayak launch. Dogs on leash are allowed and horses are also allowed on a 1-mile stretch of the beach. All-terrain wheelchairs are available - inquire at entry station.
