Site visit to visualize existing conditions on Highway 12



The Sonoma County Regional Parks Department is preparing a feasibility study for a 13-mile bicycle and pedestrian trail along the Highway 12 corridor between Melita Road and Agua Caliente Road in the Sonoma Valley. This trail would connect Sonoma, the Springs area, Glen Ellen, Kenwood, Santa Rosa and provide a link to other destination areas. The study is funded with a community-based transportation planning grant administered by Caltrans and Sonoma County Regional Parks Department. The study will identify a preliminary trail alignment and design and prioritize trail segments for future construction. The project costs and the economic and other benefits to the community will also be assessed. Beginning September 25, 2014, the public can provide input by completing an online community survey available in English and Spanish at:

Anticipated Project Timeline:

August-October 2014: Identification of existing conditions, right of way and utility mapping, community survey, initial contact and meetings/workshops with stakeholders, interest groups, and the public.

November-December 2014: Identification and evaluation of trail alternatives, cost and benefit analysis, additional stakeholder meetings and community workshops.

January-February 2015: Further identification and evaluation of issues, opportunities and alternatives.

March-June 2015: Preparation and presentation of Draft Feasibility Study.

August-September 2015: Addressing public comments.

October-November 2015: Preparation and release of Final Feasibility Study.

December 2015: Board of Supervisors presentation and adoption.
