PARK FACILITIES FACTSHEET

Some of the park facilities Tolay Lake Regional Park will include:

Visitor Center

- Approximately 7,000 SF Visitor Center

Trails

- Up to ~ 29 miles of trails¹
- Up to ~ 20 miles of Multi-Use trails (Hike, Bike, Equestrian)
- Up to ~ 9 miles Hikers Only trails

Viewpoints/Interpretive Vistas

- Up to 12 Viewpoint/Interpretive Vistas

Camping/Overnight Areas

- 2 Backcountry Sites—Single-family type site
- 2 Group Sites—Approximately 50 people each site
- Group Bunkhouse—Potentially holding up to 40 campers
 - 4,600 SF

Picnic Areas

- 5 Picnic Areas with tables scattered in appropriate spots along trails

Kitchen and Dining Area

- To accommodate educational program or special events
- 2,000 SF indoor kitchen and 1,000 SF covered outdoor dining

¹ Includes ~ 16 miles of new trails less ~ 8 miles of poorly designed decommissioned trails/ranch roads

Parking

- Auto
 - Daily Parking Area – Up to 80
 - South Entrance – Up to 25
 - Events Parking, additional at Tolay Lake – Up to 300
 - Events Parking, additional north – Up to 200
- Equestrian Parking
 - Main North Park Entrance – Up to 15
 - South Entrance – Up to 4
